Definitions:

- 1. CPI Increase:** The CPI used in the calculation of the sanction index is the "all urban consumers (current series), all goods" annual index. This was the index specified in most recent legislation. Between 2004 and 2006, the CPI increased by 6.72%.
- 2. Sanction Index:** The Sanction Index is the proposed metric for determining "affordability". It is calculated by dividing the increase in tuition/fees over the most recent three year period by the increase in the Consumer Price Index over the same period of time. A Sanction Index of 2 (meaning tuition/fees have increased more than two times the rate of inflation) is the proposed threshold for sanctioning.
- 3. Sanctioned?:** Under proposed legislation, an institution with a Sanction Index of 2 or more would be subject to sanctions. The specific sanctions, and provisions for exemptions, vary slightly depending on the specific legislation. Grey shading indicates institutions that exceed this threshold.
