Retention and Graduation Rates of New Freshmen Pell Grant Recipients by Fall Semester Entrance Cohort

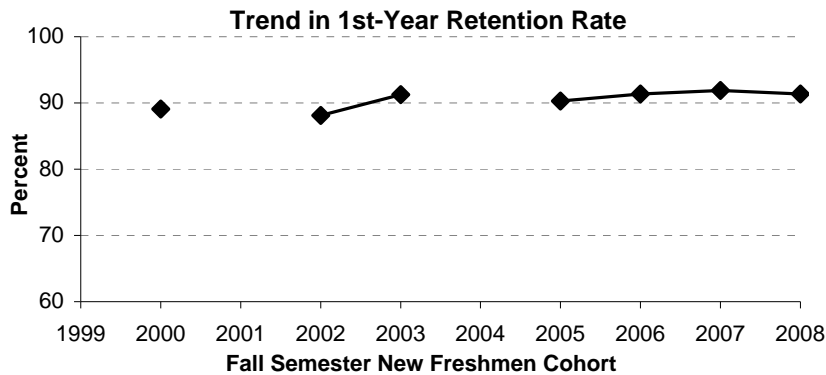
