Data for peer universities includes 2007-08 degree recipients at Cornell, Illinois, Iowa State, Kansas, Michigan, Michigan State, Minnesota, Penn State, Pittsburgh, Purdue, Texas, and UC Santa Barbara, AND 2006-07 degree recipients at Washington, Arizona, Virginia, Colorado, Ohio State, Indiana, and SUNY-Buffalo. Peer data includes only those degrees awarded in discipline areas comparable to UW-Madison degree/majors, based upon on the federal Classification of Instructional Programs(CIP). Degrees awarded with multiple majors are counted under each of their multiple majors, but are counted only once in the total summary line. Some peer institutions are on quarter calendars rather than semester calendars. In these cases, their term counts and student credit hours have been converted to a semester basis for purposes of comparability. Some UW-Madison undergraduate programs share the same peer comparison groups. As a result, some of the peer comparison groups appear twice in this table. The total summary line, however, includes each peer comparison group only once. For some UW-Madison majors peer comparison groups are not available, at least within the group of institutions participating in the AAUDE survey at this time.
